OPTUS STADIUM - CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The following Conditions of Entry apply to all patrons (Patron(s)) attending events or functions at Optus Stadium.

These Conditions of Entry are to be read in conjunction with conditions of entry that may apply to (i) a particular event (Event Conditions, refer to the event page at www.Optusstadium.com.au); (ii) the ticketing agent's terms and conditions of ticket sale (Ticket Conditions, refer to www.ticketmaster.com.au/h/purchase.html; and/or (iii) specific conditions of sports governing bodies (Specific Conditions, refer below). Each of these conditions may include additional terms to those set out in these Conditions of Entry.

Specific Conditions of entry will apply for each event of the Australian Football League (AFL), Cricket Australia (CA), the National Rugby League (NRL), and Football Federation Australia (FFA):

- AFL - Conditions of Entry
- Cricket Australia - Ticket & Entry Conditions, National Refund Policy, Policy Statement on Inappropriate Conduct
- NRL - Event Conditions
- FFA - Terms of Admission

Specific Conditions will be available from the website of the respective sports governing bodies.

Patrons who fail to comply with the Conditions of Entry, Event Conditions, Ticket Conditions and/or Specific Conditions will be refused entry to Optus Stadium. Patrons who have been admitted but subsequently refuse to comply with the Conditions of Entry, Event Conditions, Ticket Conditions and/or Specific Conditions (as applicable) may be removed from Optus Stadium without refund or compensation of any kind under any circumstances.

Optus Stadium reserves the right to update, modify or change these Conditions of Entry from time to time. Any changes will be posted and available at www.Optusstadium.com.au at entry points to Optus Stadium. Each of the ticketing agent and sports governing bodies reserves the right to update, modify or change the Ticket Conditions or Special Conditions (as applicable), and changes will be posted and available at the applicable website.

Refusal of Entry

Optus Stadium reserves the right to refuse entry to any:

- Patron it deems to be intoxicated, drug affected, disorderly, threatening or abusive;
- Unauthorised Patron;
- Patron carrying items which have the potential to compromise safety, or cause injury or public nuisance;
- Patron not holding a valid ticket, including tickets purchased from an unauthorised source, from a ticket scalper, or which appears to have been defaced, forged or copied;
- Patron who refuses to be checked or submit its belongings for inspection; or
- Vehicle where a Patron refuses to comply with the vehicle security check process.

General Conditions

- Optus Stadium reserves the right to inspect and search bags, regardless of size, of all Patrons who enter or exit Optus Stadium. This may include touching the outside of the bag and / or seeking assistance of the bag owner to remove items from the bag.
- Optus Stadium reserves the right to conduct personal checks of all Patrons who enter or exit Optus Stadium. This may include pat down searches and/or wandings.
- Patrons must not attempt to conceal their identity, either at the point of entry or while inside Optus Stadium. Optus Stadium will respect cultural differences and medical conditions, but reserves the right to refuse entry to, or remove from, Optus Stadium anyone who covers their face with a scarf, balaclava, mask, helmet, etc.
- The wearing of any 'colours' or 'insignia' signifying belonging to any outlaw motorcycle club (OMC) or other group as designated by Police, is prohibited. This includes coats, T-shirts, waistcoats, caps, patches etc. that indicate a Patron belongs to any OMC or other prohibited group.
- Patrons wearing or otherwise displaying inappropriate or unauthorised commercial, political, religious or other offensive images, logos, messages etc. may be denied entry into Optus Stadium or asked to remove such items prior to entering Optus Stadium.
- Patrons gaining unauthorised access to Optus Stadium and/or the pitch/playing field may be evicted from Optus Stadium and may be subject to penalties, including imprisonment and fines.
- Patrons who become intoxicated, drug affected, disorderly, threatening or abusive, cause a disturbance, or refuse to comply with any direction, request or announcements made by Stadium staff, will be evicted from Optus Stadium.
- Patrons must occupy the seat specified on their ticket.
- Unless otherwise specified, children 12 years and under will not be admitted without a parent or guardian (16 years or older), and must remain with them at all times. Patrons must comply with any age specifications or restrictions detailed on the ticket.
- Smoking is not permitted within the main Optus Stadium entry fence line. Patrons must utilise the smoking areas at least 5m from Optus Stadium entry points. Patrons who smoke, other than in the designated smoking areas, commit an offence and may be subject to penalties, including fines.
- Patrons wishing to bring permitted items into Optus Stadium do so at their own risk. Optus Stadium will not be held responsible for any damage to, loss or theft of a Patron's personal property.

- Umbrellas may be brought into Optus Stadium but for the comfort of others should not be put up.
- For safety reasons, strollers and prams are not permitted in Optus Stadium seating bowl. Strollers and prams may be stored in cloakrooms provided adjacent to the entry gates.
- Unauthorised soliciting and customer surveying is not permitted within Optus Stadium.
- Patrons are not permitted to throw any objects around or within Optus Stadium. Patrons identified as throwing objects will be evicted from Optus Stadium.
- Some sporting and other activities conducted at sporting and entertainment venues are dangerous. Risks include collision with fixed or moving objects, falling or tripping, exposure to adverse weather, or acts of violence committed by other Patrons. All Patrons attending events and functions at Optus Stadium do so at their own risk. Optus Stadium is not responsible or liable for any loss, damage, accident or injury suffered by any Patron, including that of any children under their care.
- Tickets to events at Optus Stadium or the Stadium Park may not be used in relation to any unauthorised promotion or competition. Promotional or commercial activities within Optus Stadium or the Stadium Park, in relation to an event or function or otherwise, are not permitted. Patrons who conduct any unauthorised activities will be required to immediately cease such activities and may be evicted from Optus Stadium and the Stadium Park. Patrons holding tickets sourced through unauthorised promotional or commercial activities may be denied access to Optus Stadium.
- Optus Stadium may photograph and record event crowds from time to time, and may use these photographs and recordings for any media or other purpose, including advertising or promotional purposes, without payment of any kind to Patrons.
- Patrons are advised that strobe lighting may be utilised for events at Optus Stadium.
- For the safety and security of Patrons and other Stadium occupants closed circuit television cameras are in use at this Stadium. Photographs and recordings of Patrons may be shared with the police and other authorities.

Restricted / Prohibited Items

Patrons and Ticket Holders are not permitted to bring the following restricted / prohibited items into Optus Stadium:

- Glassware, glass bottles or cans, including spray cans.
- Alcoholic beverages.
- Illegal substances, including illegal drugs.
- Flares, fireworks, weapons, explosives or smoke bombs.
- Laser pointers.
- Knives or other dangerous weapons.
- Pets or animals other than assistance dogs.
- Folding chairs or stools.
- Cameras and or recording devices (for commercial purposes) including tripods. Personal photography is permitted, provided photographs are for non-commercial use.
- Remote control vehicles, including drones (or any such aircraft).
- Metal flag poles, extendable flag poles and / or flag poles of more than 1.6 metres in length.
- Oversized banners and flags which are deemed to cause public nuisance. Specific conditions may apply for some events regarding the entry of flagpoles, flags, and banners.
- Musical instruments and noise makers, including whistles, hooters, horns, drums, and vuvuzelas. Specific conditions may apply for some events regarding the entry of musical instruments including drums.
- Confetti or shredded paper.
- Balloons or other inflatable items.
- Scooters, roller skates, skateboards, segways and push bikes.
- Electronic cigarettes (e-cig or e-cigarettes), personal vaporisers, electronic nicotine delivery systems, or other battery powered vaporisers are not permitted to be consumed anywhere in Optus Stadium.
- Hard Eskies and bags of larger dimensions that are unable to be stored under the seats.
- Other items as determined by Optus Stadium that may cause damage, harm or public nuisance.

Please note the above Conditions of Entry may vary between events and reference should also be made to any Specific Conditions, Event Conditions and Ticket Conditions.

Alcohol & Illegal Drugs

Patrons entering Optus Stadium are advised that:

- Alcoholic beverages cannot be brought into or removed from Optus Stadium by Patrons. It is an offence to bring alcohol into this venue under the Liquor Control Act. Any breach of this Act may result in fines being applied.
- Intoxicated or drug affected Patrons will not be permitted to enter Optus Stadium, and if later found to be intoxicated or drug affected will be evicted.
- Patrons in possession of alcohol or illegal drugs will not be permitted to enter Optus Stadium, and if later found to be in possession of alcohol or illegal drugs will be evicted.
- Checking procedures will apply to prevent Patrons from entering Optus Stadium with alcohol or illegal drugs.

Dress Standards

- Premium Product, Member and Dining Room areas of Optus Stadium will be subject to dress codes with a higher minimum standard than required for general admission to Optus Stadium. As a guide, smart casual attire is the minimum standard required for Premium Product, Member and Dining Room areas.
- As a minimum for general admission, patrons must be appropriately clothed for a public place and must wear shoes. Patrons with bare feet will not be permitted entry to Optus Stadium.
